## Babylonian Talmud Baba Batra 21a

שאלמלא הוא נשתכח תורה מישראל, שבתחלה מי שיש לו אב מלמדום תורה... ותיקן שיהו מושיבין למדי תינוקות בכל מדינה ומדינה ובכל עיר ועיר.

She-ilmalei hu nishtakha<u>h</u> Torah mi-Yisrael, she-ba-te<u>h</u>ilah mi she-yesh lo av melam'do Torah... ve-tikein she-yehu moshivin melam'dei tinokon be-khol medinah u-medinah u-ve-khol ir va-ir.

Gedolah gemilut <u>h</u>asadim yoter min ha-tzedakah: tzedakah be-mamono, gemilut <u>h</u>asadim bein be-gufo bein be-mamono.

Kindness is greater than charity, for charity can be done only with one's money, but kindness can be done with one's person and one's money.

#### **Genesis Rabbah 76:9**

עשה עצמו כגשר.

Asah atzmo ke-gesher.

#### Mishnah Avot 1:4

יוֹסֵי בֶּן יוֹעֶזֶר אִישׁ צְרֵדָה אוֹמֵר: "יְהִי בֵיתְךְּ בֵּית וַעַד לַחֲכָמִים, וֶהֱוֵי מִתְאַבֵּק בַּעֲפַר רַגְּלֵיהֶם, וֶהֱוֵי שׁוֹתֶה בַצְּמָא אֶת דִּבְרֵיהֶם."

Shine a new light on Zion, and may we all merit its light soon!

#### Zechariah 14:7

ּוְהָיָה יוֹם־אֶחָד- הוּא יַוָּדַע לַיְהוָה- לֹא־יוֹם וְלֹא־לַיְלָה וְהָיָה לְעֵת־עֶרֶב יִהְיֶה־אוֹר!

Va-yehi khir'ot ha-melekh et Esther ha-malkah omedet be-<u>h</u>atzer, nas'ah <u>h</u>ein be-einav.

[In an act of extreme bravery, when Esther approached the King uninvited,] The King saw Queen Esther standing in the courtyard, and she found favor in his eyes.

#### Mishnah Avot 2:8

ַרבִּי אֶלְעָזָר בָּן עֲרָך- מַעְיָן הַמִּתְגַּבֵּר... אָם יִהְיוּ כָּל חַכְמֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל בְּכַף מאֹזְנַיִם... וְרַבִּי אֶלְעָזָר בָּן עֲרָךְ בְּכַף שְׁנָיָּה, מַכְרִיעַ אֶת כַּלָּם.

## Babylonian Talmud Ta'anit 7a

מה ברזל זה אחד מחדד את חבירו אף שני תלמידי חכמים מחדדין זה את זה בהלכה.

Mah barzel zeh e<u>h</u>ad me<u>h</u>aded et <u>h</u>avero, af sh'nei talmidei <u>h</u>akhamim me<u>h</u>adedin zeh et zeh be-halakhah.

## **Babylonian Talmud 37a**

קפץ נחשון בן עמינדב וירד לים תחילה.

Kafatz Na<u>h</u>shon ben Aminadav va-yered la-yam te<u>h</u>ilah.

Then, in jumped [the prince of Judah] Nahshon ben Amminadab, and descended into the [Reed] sea first, [and only then, did the sea split].
